It has come to our attention that a member of the World Service Board has willfully and blatantly destroyed the files to the Southern California Regional Service Committee of Narcotics Anonymous by way of burning them. These documents were the history of that committees proceedings during his term of office. The position of this member to the Southern California Regional Service Committee, during his term, was the Chairman. He now resides on your Board of Directors and is in close contact with the archives, of Narcotics Anonymous, which are on file at the World Service Office.

We feel that any member that is capable of this kind of wrong doing and mis-conduct, should not be allowed on the World Service Board of Directors, let alone, work at the World Service Office-especially if that member has a history of this kind if conduct. At nine years of sobriety-we feel this inexcusable.

It is our suggestion that this situation be dealt with promptly. This is a serious problem that could become worse. Our recomondation is that any member of any committee or board, who has committed an action such as this, be terminated from any such committee or service board.

We patiently await your response regarding this matter. Until we recieve your response, we feel obligated to withhold any future donations until this matter is dealt with satisfactorily.
